Main varieties available

Alicante An early maturing variety giving medium sized bright red fruit.

Big Boy Beefsteak tomato with excellent flavour. Grow as cordon in cool or warm greenhouse.

Costoluto Fiorentino Irregular shaped beefsteak tomato with excellent flavour. Best grown outside as bushes with support.

Gardeners' Delight Suitable for indoors or outside cultivation. Old favourite. Heavy crop of small to medium sized red fruit.

Harbinger Indoor or outdoor (heirloom variety). Thin skinned medium sized fruit ripens easily even in cool summers.

Moneymaker Indoors or outdoors. Medium sized fruit. Grow as cordon with support.

Roma Indoor or outdoor. Plum tomato. Tasty flesh with few seeds. Great for cooking. May need support. Grow as bush.

Shirley F1 Suitable for heated or cold greenhouse. Tasty Medium sized fruit with good disease resistance

Sub Artic Plenty Outdoors A 1940's favourite. Fruit set well in cooler conditions. No need to support or sideshoot.

Sungold F1 Suitable for indoors or outside cultivation. Cascading trusses of very sweet, bite-sized, thin skinned, rich orange fruit.

Tamina Early ripening variety with outstanding taste particularly if grown outdoors. Medium size red fruit. Plants require support but minimal side-shooting.

Vilma Bushy variety specifically bred for pots and containers. Sweet, juicy, cherry-sized, round, red fruit crop heavily over a long period. No support or side-shooting required.
